

STANDING SCHEDULING ORDER

St. 05-s-1305

State v. Gerard Beloin

DATE: July 11, 2007

Pursuant to Superior Court Rules 96-A and 98, the following scheduling order is issued in the above captioned case(s):

DISCOVERY: RULE 98 DEADLINES APPLY

State: Open File Discovery, **NO LATER THAN** 30 days after arraignment, Defense requests for additional discovery, 60 days after arraignment.

DEPOSITIONS: Must REQUEST no later than 60 days after arraignment. Must COMPLETE ALL depositions 20 days before Jury Selection.

TRANSCRIPTS: Counsel must comply with State v. Brown, and request transcripts no more than 15 days after the date of this ORDER.

WITNESS LISTS/WITNESS STATEMENTS:

State to provide: 20 days before jury selection.

Defense to provide: 10 days before jury selection.

Motions for "RICHARDS" HEARING to be filed no later than at the time of witness list provision.

DISPOSITIVE MOTIONS: to be filed not less than 45 calendar days prior to jury selection date. Objections to be filed within 10 days.

LIMINE MOTIONS: To be filed five days prior to jury selection. Written objections to be filed at or before the trial management conference. Motions filed after deadline will be returned, unless accompanied by a Motion to Accept Late Filing.

NEGOTIATED PLEAS: Prosecutor to extend an offer for negotiated plea no later than 30 days before jury selection.

DEADLINE FOR FILING NOTICE OF INTENT TO PLEAD: No negotiated plea will be accepted after the Final Conference. **WHENEVER POSSIBLE, PLEA AND SENTENCING WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE FINAL CONFERENCE.**

NOTE: STRUCTURING CONFERENCES WILL NOT BE SCHEDULED EXCEPT UPON A REQUEST BY EITHER SIDE, which request should be made within 30 days after arraignment.
