**RE: Cease and Desist**

Dear Mr. Beloin:

This firm represents the interests of the Roman Catholic Bishop of Manchester, a corporation sole, and St. Lawrence Parish and its leadership, including its pastor, Rev. Gerard Bertin.

It has come to our attention that on Sunday, September 23, 2007, you leafleted the cars parked on the premises of the St. Lawrence Parish during the celebration of mass. Your two-page narrative was defamatory and libelous against many individuals identified and referenced therein. Not only are your statements hurtful, they are false and we can only infer that you are seeking some leverage or pecuniary benefit from maligning good and decent people.

It has also come to our attention that you have either directly or indirectly intimidated members of the parish leadership and the parish community generally by, among other things, carrying a hand gun into church with you, using your physical presence as well as your words to intimidate and otherwise threaten parish leaders, volunteers, and parishioners generally, and that you have trespassed on the property of St. Lawrence Parish insofar that you have entered the premises to conduct what can be, at best, described as unrelated church business without the prior approval and consent of the pastor of St. Lawrence Parish. In summary, your very presence on the parish's property, as well as your interactions with parish leaders, are disruptive to the orderly conduct of the church's work through St. Lawrence Parish.

Accordingly, I am writing to demand that you immediately cease and desist from entering the parish property or contacting any of the parish leaders, either in writing, by telephone

or other electronic means, until further notice. I understand that other members of your family may be parishioners and are otherwise involved in programs of the parish and, as far as we are concerned, they should not be barred by our request for you to cease and desist immediately from your activities regarding participation in ordinary church activities. Please, however, do not attempt to use your immediate family members as surrogates or proxies for your tirade against the church and the parish.

Finally, please be advised that if you do not cease and desist immediately from your present activities, we will seek whatever relief is appropriate in court to enjoin you and otherwise restrain you from conducting these disruptive and threatening activities.
